**Administrative history note:** The School of Medical Sciences was created by Council on 23 July 2001 within the Faculty of Medicine to be effective from 1 August 2001, as a result of the disestablishment of the schools of Pathology, Anatomy and Physiology & Pharmacology (resolution CL001/61d). The first head of school was Professor Denis Wakefield and the school consisted of the three departments of Pathology, Anatomy and Physiology & Pharmacology, which had their origins in the schools by the same name.  
 In 2008 the head of the School of Medical Sciences was Professor Denis Wakefield.
